To Danbury Sanitary District Customers

Danbury wastewater treatment plant is working towards reducing the chlorides in the effluent, with a long-term goal of keeping it below permit levels prescribed by the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources.

The best way to reduce chlorides in the effluent is to reduce the amount entering the sewer. One of the main sources of chloride is from commercial/residential water softeners. Therefore, Danbury Sanitary District has passed an ordinance, **Chloride Reduction Plan Resolution 2024-1**. Which requires all commercial and residential users with water softeners installed are to provide Danbury Sanitary District with the annual inspection reports from a certified/qualified inspector.
